1. System Requirments

- Stationary computer or laptop (mobile devices are not supported);
- Operating system: Windows 7, Windows 8, Windows 8.1, Windows 10 or Mac OS version 10.10 or newer;
- RAM: 3GB or more;
- Free hard drive space 500 Mδ;
- Internet browser Google Chrome of the last available version (to install the brower use "https://www.google.com/chrome" link, for checking it for the latest version and updating use "chrome://settings/help" in the address tab.;
- Availability of a working and enabled front-facing webcam (including built-in in laptops) with a resolution of at least 640x480 px.;
- Availability of a working and enabled microphone (including built-in in laptops)
- Availability of stable internet connection with the data transfer speed from the user no lower than 1 Mbit/s (you can test your connection speed here https://www.speedtest.net);
- Computer must successfully pass the computer scan (scan function becomes available after authorization in Examus)

2. Preparation of the workspace before the test

In order for the testing session to succeed, immediately before the test, you must take the following steps:

- Provide good light in the room
- Check the availability and speed of your internet connection.
- Check that the camera and microphone are turned on and that the camera lens is not blocked by a plug
- Prepare an identity document
- Connect the laptop to the network (battery power may reduce device performance)
- Restart your computer to provide maximum performance.
- Turn off all unnecessary programs and tabs in the browser (use the Windows Task Manager for this, which can be called by the Ctrl + Shift + Esc key combination; the program is closed by clicking the Cancel task button)
- Remove headphones, books, and notes (unless they are allowed by exam rules)
- Disable duplicate monitors (if there are any)

3. Testing Rules

To pass the test, follow these conditions:

• Go to your page and select the *Testing* command.




Fig 1 – Testing

Choose active test




Fig 2 – Tests

• Next, activate the Start Test command.

Warning: Testing takes place with the examus system, so make sure that you have a camera and connected to your computer and Google Chrome browser is installed

Before starting test, make sure that:

- the camera and microphone of your device are connected;
- the camera lens is not covered by other objects;
- the room is sufficiently lit;
- Internet connection is working properly.




Fig 3 – Start of the test

• After that, you will be taken to the Examus extension installation page.

- Click the *Install Extension* button
- After installing the extension, the Examus icon will appear in your browser.
- Then click *Continue*.

A window will pop up where the rules for using the Examus system are written

- Read the rules
- If you agree to the terms and agree to the processing of your data, check the box
- Then click Continue




Fig 5 – Terms of Use for Examus system

Then, the Examus checks:

- Connection of the webcam
- Webcam image
- Network connection
- Lack of additional monitors
- Broadcast from the webcam and desktop

After, select the area of the screen to which you consent and click on the Share button




Fig 6 – Opening Screen Access

Next, the system will ask you to take a picture for a documentary photo

Take a picture and click on the Submit button




Fig 7 – Photo for the document

After sending the photo, Examus will process your request, and will open the testing page. You will be able to take the test.




Fig 8 – Test window
